- 4. Support program integration or overlay initiatives with other certification systems such as LEED, Sustainable Sites, etc.

B. Certification Program Management

- I. Serve as the primary point-of-contact for Salmon-Safe farm and urban inspectors in coordinating program delivery.
- 2. Coordinate delivery of Salmon-Safe specific technical training to Salmon-Safe inspectors.
- 3. Provide on-site project management for urban certification teams operating coast-wide.
- 4. Manage individual site verification of conditions and ensure project performance throughout certification cycle.
- 5. Administer Salmon-Safe's web-based project management and certification management systems, including database updates, report generation, quantification of results and workflow tracking.

C. Technical Resource for Partner Network

- 1. Track and manage site assessment requests to ensure timely and effective program delivery across the Partner Network.
- 2. Serve as resource for Partner Network staff and contractors regarding technical standards questions/issues.
- 3. Deliver technical training to partners as necessary.
